**Students** - In year 5 or 6 in September? Join Culture Club after school and you can enjoy a range of activities, workshops, guided tours and trips to explore Island culture through art and exchange. Over 12 weeks you will create your own art - this can be anything from craft, dance, poetry, photography, video or painting - whatever your experience, openness to your little exploring culture in our workshops suggests. Do show off your skills or try a new technique to show what you've made, explored and enjoyed. All you have to do is reflect your work and your thoughts in our Explore entry log as you go along and take part in the Club activities in December.

**Parents** - The weekly for after-school club starts up in Sept 9th and aims to support children to try out cultural activities whilst gaining an Arts Award Explore (entry level qualification). Chired require schools to provide cultural opportunities for children to enhance their creativity and support PSHE development. Funded by Arts Council England through the Island's Lift the Lid partnership, the club involves a minimal cost of £12 per pupil with moderation and certification costs provided for. Teachers CIC are the Island's social enterprise for cultural heritage, bringing the Island's rich culture to life for our schools since 2014.
