### Shoe Box Appeal

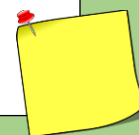

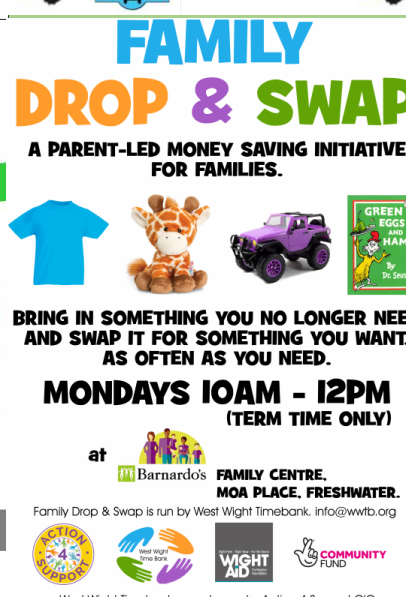
