Don't forget that our Year 4's have swimming every Tuesday morning. Please remember to pack your child a drink and healthy snack. Many thanks

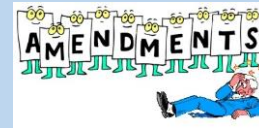


Census Day Menu Change

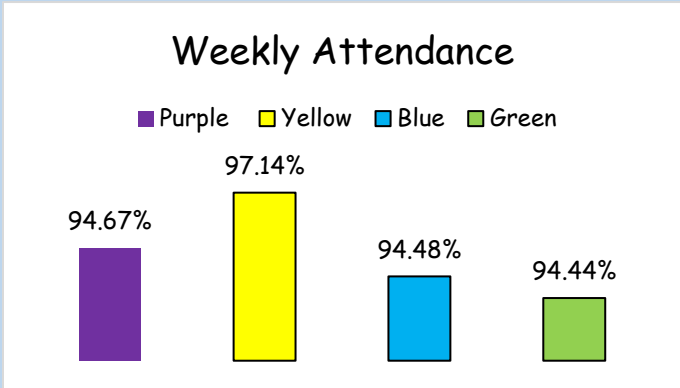
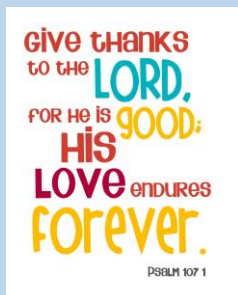
