## West Wight School Implementation Notices

Dear Parents and Carers

We have now had a first meeting with the Local Authority. These meetings will be referred to as implementation meetings moving forward. This meeting was in the first instance to introduce the various parties to each other and briefly look at a number of areas, such as Finance, Building, HR, Admissions, etc. which will be relevant in the next phase. No decisions were made at this meeting, however agreements regarding communications were reached, a summary of which is below. The plan is to hold a meeting approximately every 6 weeks.

We established the protocol for sharing information with the school and wider communities as we all recognise the importance of good communication. In brief, following each meeting, an Executive Summary will be produced, agreed and shared within two weeks. We will have a page on our website with a link to the IOW Council website where the Executive Summary will be maintained. We also intend to publish a Frequently Asked Questions document on our website and the Council Website and would encourage you to let us know any (new) questions you may have which we will look to have answered at the next meeting. We hope this will give you quick and accurate updates on the process and other pertinent information via the FAQ document. 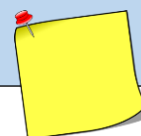

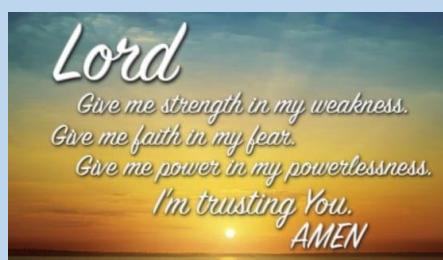
