In Year Application

You will have seen the Council's press release announcing the £4.5 million investment from the Department for Education's Priority School Building Programme (PSBP) to provide a modern, one-form entry primary school on the site of All Saints CE Primary School. Since that decision was taken the Council has been working closely with the Governing Body of Yarmouth CE Primary School and the process of relocating Yarmouth CE Primary School is an active discussion. The school will relocate into the new building in Freshwater when the building programme is finished. In the interim, from September 2020, they will **first** operate provision across both the Yarmouth and Freshwater sites.

The build programme is likely to take until the Spring term of 2022. The senior leaders and the governing body at the school will work with both communities to ensure the best possible provision for your children, and the children currently at Yarmouth CE Primary School, as the school establishes in the new building.

I am now able to run the application process for you to express a preference for a school place for your child from September 2020, following the closure of All Saints CE Primary School.

- The Council will process all applications, discussing them with the schools named, and advise parents who meet the deadline of the outcome, by email before midday 31 March 2020.

If you also have a child due to start in Reception in 2020 the Council will be writing to you about that process. I look forward to receiving your application, please meet the deadline as it will allow us to carry out all the processes that are needed at this time.
