## KEY AREA OF LEARNING - GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY

During the Spring term, the children will be learning all about the Mediterranean. We will be looking at where Mediterranean countries are and finding out about what it would be like to live or visit there. We will be locating different countries and oceans, learning about the climate and landmarks and why it is the most visited holiday destination in the world! Eventually, we will create our own brochures to explain what makes it such an amazing place to visit.

### SCIENCE

In Science we will be learning all about the different types of rocks and how we can group and classify these. We will be exploring the three main types of rock as well learning all about how rocks are made.

For the second half of the term we will be exploring how light exists, how light can move in different ways and what this called and also how we see light in our eyes.

### ENGLISH

We will begin by discovering about volcanoes and will be creating our very own shapes poems to present and perform.

Then we will be going on a journey to Italy and reading the text 'Escape from Pompeii'. We will have some different writing challenges in response to what we discover through this book.

Our second text for the Half Term will be Winters Child, here we will learn all about inference and deductions.

### MATHS

During Spring one, Year 3 will be working on multiplication and division and how these link together. They will work on different methods of calculating as well as reasoning and problem solving.

We will be also focusing on our Times Tables and completely lessons based on fluency and even a weekly Maths Puzzle.
