Tucasi Payments

We are writing to inform you of some important changes we are making concerning the booking of and paying for After School Clubs. We hope that this will simplify the booking process for parents, ensuring that at the time of booking and paying you will have the knowledge that their place is confirmed for their chosen activity. Therefore School Trips and After School Club activities must be booked and paid for in advance through Scopay on a first come first served basis. This alone will guarantee your child's place. Non-payment via Scopay in advance or non-return of completed slips may result in your child not being able to attend. We will no longer accept cash payments for Trips and Clubs. (The only exception would be if the teacher, such as a dance teacher etc. needs to be paid directly.)
