HELP US GET AN EXTRA £1320 PER CHILD FOR YARMOUTH!

Dear Parents,

Did you know that if you are in receipt of certain benefits, not only could your child be entitled to receive a free school meal (saving you over £400 per year), but Yarmouth could also receive extra funding as well?

Even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and is already receiving a free school meal through the Government's Universal Infant Free School Meal initiative, you should still let the council know if you are eligible as this could unlock vital cash for the school.

In fact, it could mean that the school receives an additional amount of £1320 per pupil for the next six years, even if your circumstances change.

The Pupil Premium is paid to schools to support children's learning and help boost their achievements. This additional money can be used to help fund extra staffing, purchase essential equipment including ICT and books, and subsidising the costs of activities.

From Year 3 onwards, your child could be entitled to a free healthy hot meal every day, saving you £10.75 a week, or £419.25 over an entire year!

If you think you may be entitled, please fill out the form attached and return it to the school office. We will deal with your application confidentially and with discretion. Alternatively, you can send it back to the council address on the form.

In any case, please fill out the form below and return it to us so that we can ensure that our records are up to date, and your child is getting their full entitlement. **Please return by Friday 18**th **November 2016.**
