Drop off/pick up

The current drop off and pick up scheme seems to be working well, therefore the timings will remain in place for September.

Year 5	8.20am	3.10pm	Drop off or Around the school and into/out of the Year 5 and 6 block
Year 6	8.20am	3.10pm	Drop off or Around the school and into/out of the Year 5 and 6 block

Younger siblings to be dropped off & picked up at the older sibling time.

Uniform

Please ensure that your child has the correct uniform which is named! Our uniform is as follows:

White shirt/polo shirt
Bottle green sweatshirt/cardigan/jumper
Dark grey trousers/skirt/pinafore
Summer dress – green gingham
Shoes – black shoes or plain all black trainers
Book bag or ruck sack

White t-shirt (logo or plain)
Black or Dark Green PE shorts/skorts

PE/Forest School days

For the first two days back at school, please can children come to school in their normal uniform. The class teacher will do out the PE & Forest School timetable during the first week.

If your child requires before and after school care, please contact Little Explorers to make arrangements.

After School Clubs

After school clubs and activities will resume during the Autumn term.

Independent Leavers

With written permission, the year 6 children are able to leave school independently. This is with the clear understanding that once the child has left the school premises, responsibility for them reverts back to parents. Please ensure that your child can get home safely and is confident to do so.

If you would like your child to leave independently, please contact the school office for a permission form.

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COVID-19

We are busy updating our risk assessments ready for September, this will be available to you once they are finalised.

School Dinners & Packed Lunches

In September our catering providers will be Chartwells. The price of a school meal will be £2.15. We have attached a menu for your perusal.

If your child has a medically diagnosed food allergy, please contact the school office as you will need to complete a form for Chartwells.

Don't forget that all children are entitled to free school meals in the first three years of primary school (Reception Class, Year 1 & Year 2), regardless of income. If your child is entering Year 3, please be aware that you will now start paying for any dinners taken.

Water bottles – please ensure that your child has a water bottle for use in class.

Tucasi/Scopay

Please ensure that you have logged onto Scopay to book your child a dinner ready for the first week back.

Reception Class – the office will be happy to book this for you whilst you wait for your Tucasi codes to be issued. Reception Class staff will check lunch boxes, any child without a packed lunch will receive a school dinner.

Office Times

Please be aware that the office will be closed for the duration of the school holidays. Admin will return to the office on 31st August.

Medical/Permission Forms

These will be sent home during the first full week back at school.

We would like to take this opportunity to wish you all a safe and happy summer holidays and thank you for your understanding of the restrictions that we have had to put in place. We look forward to September and welcoming the children back to the new academic year.
