Dear Parents.

Due to new Government Legislation regarding the number of hours children should be in school per week, we are adjusting our drop off and pick up times from September.

Children are entitled to 32.5 hours per week in school - equating to 6.5 hours per day.

At the Federation, our learning day will begin at 8.30am and finish at 3.00pm.

Yarmouth Arrangements

At Yarmouth, the school gates will open at 8.15am.

Children in Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 will wait on the main playground and be accompanied into school by a member of staff at 8.25am.

Children in Years 4, 5 and 6 can wait outside their allotted modular and will be welcomed by a member of the staff team at 8.25am. We expect parents/carers to stay with the children until a member of staff comes to collect them.

At home time, the gates will be opened at 2.50pm. At 3.00pm, Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 will be brought to the main playground to be greeted by their adults. At 3.05pm, children in Years 4,5 and 6 will be brought out of their modular building to meet their adult.

Transport to school via bus - Details to be confirmed by School Transport. Please be assured that your child will have arrived in time for the start of school at 8.30am and will leave after 3.00pm.

Independent Leavers

If your child is in Year 5 or Year 6 and you wish them to be an independent leaver. Please can you contact the school office where they will provide you with the relevant consent paperwork.

Early Morning Club

We will still operate our Early Morning drop off scheme where children are welcomed to school from 8.00am where they will go into their classrooms. We offer this service free of charge. Please remember to book your child in for morning club via the Scopay (Tucasi) system.

After School Club

We will still be offering our After School Club Care until 4.00pm Monday - Friday. This can be booked via Scopay at £4.50 per hour.
