Objective 2 – Unify

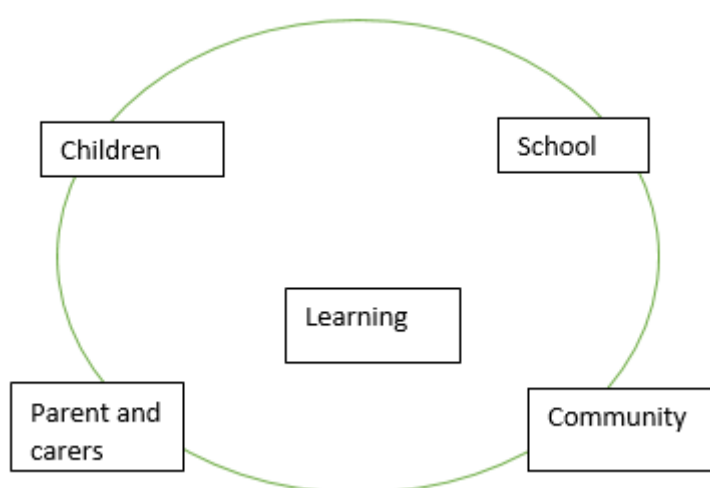
We all share the future vision of our Federation.

Reasons for Focus Area:

We have been through significant change over the last 5 years. We are at the point of major change as Yarmouth C.E. Primary School is moving to its new site in Freshwater and Shalfleet C.E. Primary School embarks upon a programme of school building improvement. We have had a significant number of new children joining the Federation. This has brought together two communities. We are now going to re look at our identity, values, beliefs and what we need now and in the future.
