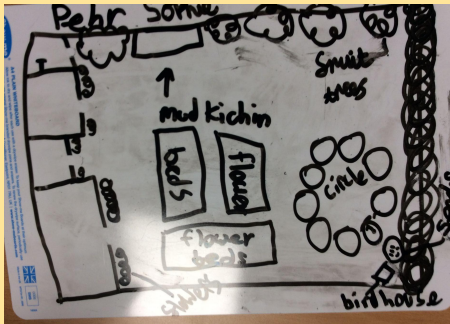


Outdoor Learning - 3rd January 2023
