It's been a wonderful week seeing the children initiating games together. This week in particular there has been a fascination with dice! Teaming up with each other the children went off & collected items to use for their dice games. With a wooden sorting tray, buttons, and a dice, the children took it in turns to roll the dice, counting out that number of buttons, sorting them into the tray & even comparing their quantities to see who had the most & least! Some brilliant collaborative play totally child initiated! This led on to exploring subitising; trying alternative items than buttons to count; even rolling the dice & counting out actions such as clapping.

Another thing we have been learning about this week inspired by the children is 'patterns', this interest generated lots of activities such as making patterns with colours, shapes, movements, and musical instruments!




