Brrrrrrr! There's nothing like having a flap around to warm you up on a chilly morning! We watched different birds gliding, flapping, swooping and diving and had a go at imitating them. Can you guess which birds we are?















At each school we have built a bird hide so we can keep ourselves hidden while we watch. We tried playing recordings of birdsong to attract the birds and found that robins are quite chatty!

















The secret to successful birdwatching is to be quiet and still. You can watch birds from anywhere, even from your window and you don't need any special equipment.
