To help us learn to recognise birds, we've been doing some drawings too. We used information books and fact files to help us. What do you think of our amazing artwork?
























We made sure we kept track of all the birds we have seen in our gardens so we can report back to the RSPB as part of the Big Schools' Birdwatch.
