Why have you chosen the subject or age group in which you are applying to train?

Do you have an understanding of the demands of teaching as well as the potential rewards?

What personal qualities do you possess that would make you a good teacher?

How you could contribute to a school outside of the classroom?

Any past experience you have working with children or young people, and what you learnt

Expertise you have gained at work or through clubs/hobbies which may be transferable to teaching.
