We do our best to help you make good educational progress. We teach you how to recognise risks in different situations and how to protect yourself and stay safe.

Safeguarding

How will we try to protect you?

- Act efficiently towards bullying.
- They provide a safe and secure environment for us to learn and grow
- We learn about things that may cause us harm
- We can access support in and outside of school
- We learn how and where to access help whenever we need it

What happens next?

If we talk to a member of staff they will need to talk to either Mrs Grainger, Mrs Westhorpe, Mrs Eggleton, or Mrs Thompson.

Sometimes the SLT may need to contact some other agencies for support. These may be Children's social care or the police. There are lots of other agencies who support children and their families as well.

Staff will talk us and explain all of this to us and we can always go and ask staff questions if we are unsure about anything.

If you need to talk- staff will always listen. You can talk to any adult within the school, anyone you feel comfortable talking to will listen and help you.
