<p><b>Create</b> a list of 20 famous ships through, time.  e.g Cutty Sark, Mary Rose</p>	<p><b>Create</b> your own model of the Mary Rose in Tudor times, using junk modelling.</p>	<p><b>Write</b> your own underwater story.</p>
<p><b>Create</b> your own travel brochure for St Lucia. Include what there is to do, places to visit, what the weather will be like and other tourist information.</p>	<p><b>Produce your own</b> table of countries, their capitals, flags, surrounding seas / oceans/countries and interesting features (human or physical!)</p>	<p><b>Draw</b> a timeline of ship construction. This needs to cover the Tudor, Victorian and present-day ships. These need to be labelled.</p>
